Last Meeting (Jan. 30, 2012)

SC SportsTalk Phil Kornblut offered his opinions on the state of USC and Clemson football. Both universities have top 10 recruiting classes scheduled to enroll this fall, which include highly ranked quarterbacks. The recent on field success of each program has led to better recruits each year. USC might have had a blessing in disguise by not winning the SEC East. They were able to focus on their bowl game and 11th win instead of having to face LSU. USC is currently 5 players over the NCAA limit of 85 and will be forced to cut 5 scholarships this fall. Phil believes Coach Spurrier will retire if he ever wins an SEC title. Clemson's upcoming challenges are breaking in a new offensive line and new Defense Coordinator. If these two challenges are met, they will compete for an ACC championship. Clemson does not currently have a full recruiting class, but was able to get 8 players to enroll early. This is much higher than most programs and will give them a head start on spring ball. Phil cautioned against placing too much emphasis on 18 year old high school kids and their respective rankings.
